A Guide to Construction at PVN

NOVEMBER 23-27

- Village Forest Road will be closed beginning at the Information Center. Please choose an alternative route to get around this road closure.
- Dirt will continue to be hauled from The Hawthorne excavation area to a future development site in Forney, TX.
- Excavation will take approximately three to four weeks.
- Expect trucks to come and go from Gate 2 the majority of the days.
- The excavation will expand from Monie Chapel to Brush Arbor Road. Please choose another route into the Corrigan Building.
- This week the final type of bricking will be chosen for the new gate house.
- Expect construction to the Spa Café in the next three to four weeks. More information will follow in the coming weeks.
